Duns is 15 miles (approx) from the town of Berwick upon Tweed (which has a main line railway station) and 40 miles (approx) from Edinburgh. The local Borders towns of Kelso, Melrose, Jedburgh are steeped in history and well worth a visit. Just over the border you have the attractions of Etal and Ford. There are various activities available locally or further a field.

The cottage is tastefully furnished and decorated to a high standard. The accommodation consists of Front Bedroom with twin beds (these can be made up into a double bed on request), Back Bedroom with twin beds (travel cot available), Lounge with wood burning stove, Fitted Kitchen, bathroom with bath and shower, WC and wash hand basin. Garden to front and rear. Gas Central Heating. TV. Private parking.

WALKING - On your doorstep short walks around the castle nature reserve. Within 7 miles you can walk a section of the Southern Upland Way.


GOLF - Duns has its own 18 hole golf course. There are also courses at Coldstream, Kelso, Gifford and in the Lothians.
